Topic: Main Street Bridge

Speaker: Jim Siebert, P.E. – DLZ Ohio, Inc.

Construction is underway for the new Main Street Bridge across the Scioto River in downtown Columbus. The bridge will be a unique structure having an inclined, single-rib tied arch. This structure will be the first of its kind in the United States, and one of only a few in the world.

Mr. Siebert will present an overview of the design of this signature bridge and discuss several of its unique features. He will also share pictures of selected construction activities and artist renderings of the final bridge.

After the presentation, we will go outside and visit the site, which is right next door to COSI. Tom Graf with Kokosing and Jim Welter with ODOT will describe the project's construction. Please wear appropriate footwear and bring a hard hat if you have one.
